



## Biodiversity in open landscapes - *Mångfald på slätten*

- The aim is to stimulate farmers applying measures that are simple and reasonable to implement in order to achieve greater biodiversity in intensive areas of farming
- The project promotes win-win situations; measures that are positive for ecosystem services and at the same time increases yields, as by enhancing the number of pollinators and predatory insects
- The measures are seldom coupled to an actual payment, but the project has shown, for example how to use the Ecological Focus Areas (EFA) in ways that increases the biodiversity in the field
- Demonstration farms were initiated to illustrate measures in reality
